Year 5 are taking part in the Jump2It! Dance Festival, which takes place at Loughborough Town Hall.

Jump2It! is the flagship performance festival for schools with Team Charnwood and gives children the opportunity to show case their talent in a professional and non-competitive performance environment.

All the children will take part in rehearsals during PE, with a professional dance artist and will have chance to learn technique as well as create their own choreography. This year, the show will be based on the theme of books to celebrate the joy of reading. But if your child does not want to take part in the performance please indicate on the reply slip.

Performance Information

The children will perform on Monday 25th March at 7pm and the show will last approximately 1 hour.

On the day of the show, the children taking part will be travelling from school via coaches at approximately 1pm. They will rehearse at the venue during the afternoon and remain there until the end of the performance. A letter detailing what the children will need to bring them will be sent out nearer the time.

Photo and Media Consent

In previous years, there has been a professional photographer to capture the show, and Jump2It! have also videoed the performances.

This is what Jump2It! do with these photos and videos...

- Children will have a photo in the programme. Names (first name and last name initial only eg Jessica T) will be included next to the photo in a list. Individual children will **not** be identified.
- The performances are videoed by JumpStart Dance and the footage will be sent out to each school as a memento. Individual children will **not** be identified. Video footage will **not** be distributed or made available for sale.
- There will be a photographer at the theatre to document the event for JumpStart
- The local press **may** visit to take photos – these images may be included on their website and/or newspaper
- A small selection of photos and a short edited version of the video will be included on the JumpStart website primaryschooldance.co.uk

- The videos and photos may be used during JumpStart INSET event to demonstrate good practice to teachers
