Have a lovely weekend and see you on Tuesday.

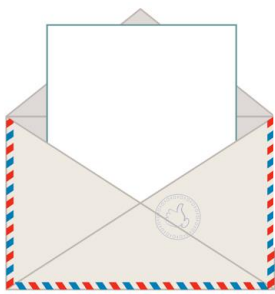
