A message from Miss Allison

Dear families

Another week has gone past in a flash and we have been very busy across the school. Our Year 6 children finished their bikeability training today which means that they are able to cycle locally with a better awareness of the roads and expectations.

In assembly this week we talked about our local priorities to help keep our children and families safe and this included a discussion on road, rail, water, fire and cycling safety. We have managed to get the Leicestershire Road Safety Team in to complete workshops with several of our classes.

As a school staff, we had our Operation Encompass training refreshed this week. We have posters up about this in and around school. What this means is that should the Police be called to a property where there is a domestic disturbance, school get informed which then helps us provide any support that our children might need. There is a link with more information in the family support section.

This term too, new rules have come into force about children having mobile phones at school. They are allowed to bring them, but we have a system where they get switched off and then handed to the class teacher and are locked away so they don't have access to them again until home time. Our secondary schools will have their own system in place.

We haven't been back long but there are a few sniffles already... a reminder that children are fine to come to school and that we have school paracetamol (Calpol) we can give them. We will always ask if it is ok to administer and we log and email you the dosage and time. A reminder please about appointments too. Where possible they should be made outside of school hours.

Another reminder – sorry... uniform. Please label your children's jumpers etc...we already have a large amount of lost property and we can't give it back unless it is labelled so we would be grateful if you could check it please. Thank you.

Lots this term to look forward to with trips being planned and the excitement for Years 3/4/5/6 for Young Voices too – please keep a look out on the calendar for events etc. Have a wonderful weekend.
